A: He has spoken N: He hasn't spoken I: Has he spoken? I.N.: Hasn't he spoken?	A: He has been speaking N: He hasn't been speaking I: Has he been speaking? I.N.: Hasn't he been speaking?
PAST	A: He spoke N: He didn't speak I: Did he speak? I.N.: Didn't he speak?	A: He was speaking N: He wasn't speaking I: Was he speaking? I.N.: Wasn't he speaking?	A: He had spoken N: He hadn't spoken I: Had he spoken? I.N.: Hadn't he spoken?	A: He had been speaking N: He hadn't been speaking I: Had he been speaking? I.N.: Hadn't he been speaking?
FUTURE	A: He will speak N: He won't speak I: Will he speak? I.N.: Won't he speak?	A: He will be speaking N: He won't be speaking I: Will he be speaking? I.N.: Won't he be speaking?	A: He will have spoken N: He won't have spoken I: Will he have spoken? I.N.: Won't he have spoken?	A: He will have been speaking N: He won't have been speaking I: Will he have been speaking? I.N.: Won't he have been speaking?

A: Affirmative (Positive) sentence; **N:** Negative sentence; **I:** Interrogative sentence. **I.N.:** Interrogative Negative sentence

PRE-SENT	S + V ₁	S + be + V ₁ +ing (be = am/is/are)	S + have/has + V ₃	S + have/has + been + V ₁ +ing
PAST	S + V ₂	S + be + V ₁ +ing (be = was/were)	S + had + V ₃	S + had + been + V ₁ +ing
FU-TURE	S + shall/will + V ₁	S + shall/will + be + V ₁ +ing	S + will + have + V ₃	S + will + have + been + V ₁ +ing

S = Subject; V₁ & V₂ & V₃ = Verb Forms
